FINAL JUDGMENT

This cause came on for hearing on November 16, 2012, upon the Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Powell Construction Services, Inc., pursuant to Rule 56, *Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure* against Plaintiffs Dean E. Kelly and Lauren M. Brunelle (Document #66). After having heard from counsel, and having reviewed and considered the pleadings, evidentiary submissions, briefs and law, the Court found that said Motion was well taken and due to be sustained.


Accordingly, on February 27, 2013, the Court ORDERED and ADJUDGED that Powell Construction Services, Inc.'s Motion for Summary Judgment was granted with final judgment being entered dismissing the action against Powell Construction Services, Inc. The Court hereby adopts by reference and incorporates as if set forth fully herein the Court's findings of fact and conclusions of law within said order (Documents #208-214). Now, be it hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that there are no genuine issues of material fact, that Powell Construction Services, Inc., is entitled to judgment as a matter of law pursuant to Rule 56, *Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure*, that there is no just reason for delay and, therefore, pursuant to Rule 54(b), *Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure*, final judgment is hereby made in favor of Powell Construction Services, Inc., and all claims asserted against Powell Construction Services, Inc., by Plaintiffs Dean E. Kelly and Lauren M. Brunelle are dismissed with prejudice with each party to bear its own costs.
